**Description:** j.c. brennan & associates, Inc. assessed the existing noise environment, implementation measures, and potential noise impacts and mitigation measures within the existing Ski Area Master Plan. The analysis evaluated compliance with the Tahoe Regional Planning Agency noise level criteria, and progress for achieving the Environmental Noise Thresholds. The report analyzed impacts, implementation measures and mitigation measures associated with snowmaking operations, avalanche control, roadway traffic, amphitheater events and construction activities.

**Description:** j.c. brennan, Inc. prepared the Noise Section of the EIR which discussed the existing noise environment in the project vicinity, and identified potential noise impacts and mitigation measures related to the proposed Buena Vista Landfill Soil Stockpile Project. Specifically, this section analyzed potential noise impacts associated with heavy equipment operations and refuse delivery trucks onsite, and roadway traffic noise levels.

**Description:** j.c. brennan & associates, inc. prepared the Noise Section of the EIR to address the noise impacts due to and upon the proposed North Sacramento Recycling Transfer Station project alternative locations within the City of Sacramento, California. Traffic on roadways adjacent to the project site, transfer station operations, and on-site truck circulation in the vicinity of the project site were considered to be potentially significant noise sources which may affect adjacent land uses and the project design. The section discussed the existing noise environment in the immediate project vicinities, and identified potential impacts and mitigation measures related to the project.

**Description:** j.c. brennan & associates, Inc. prepared a report to address the noise impacts due to and upon the proposed Five Bridges Annexation Specific Plan Area located within Merced County, California. Traffic on roadways within or adjacent to the project site, Union Pacific Railroad (UPRR) train operations along the project site, and the Merced Municipal Airport were considered to be potentially significant transportation noise sources which may affect the project design. The section discussed the existing noise environment in the immediate project vicinity, and identified potential impacts and mitigation measures related to the project.
